# SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS REGARDING THE CCL#2 DOCKET FOR THE WEEKS OF 4/13/2020 TO 5/8/20

The following applies to proceedings scheduled for the weeks of April 13, 2020 through May 8, 2020 and those weeks only.

These temporary changes are being made in response to the Coronavirus/Covid-19 outbreak, and are intended to minimize the number of people at the Bell County Justice Center.

#### Jury Trials

All Jury Trials and Jury Trial Docket Calls will be rescheduled to later dates. The Court Coordinator will give notice of the new settings.

### Pleas in cases where the defendant is out on bond.

If the defendant is set for a plea, the case will be reset and a new plea date assigned by the Court Coordinator. This will be done automatically and requires no further action by attorneys or defendants. Attorneys and bond companies, however, should advise their clients not to appear for pleas. The Court Coordinator will give notice of the new court dates.

If an attorney has a defendant on bond who has some urgent need to proceed on their case, contact the Court and reasonable accommodations will be made when possible.

## Defendants in Jail

Essential Jail pleas will continue. The Jail may need to transport inmates in smaller numbers than usual. Proceedings may be conducted remotely as feasibly. Everyone's patience is appreciated.

We are giving priority to cases in which the defendant is in custody. Attorneys with defendants in jail should contact the County Attorney about possibly expediting these cases, even if the case is not set for the current week. If needed, we should also be able to hear other jail pleas during the week, in addition to those set on the Tuesday and Friday jail docket.

#### Pretrial and Revocation Announcements

Attorneys should use Case Setting Forms and Agreed Motions for Continuance to make pretrial and revocation announcements. Defendant's signature on Case Setting Forms will not be required.

Defendants should not appear at the Wednesday 1:15 p.m. docket for pretrial and revocation announcements until after May 8, 2020.
