**FIRST AMENDED ORDER EXTENDING DEADLINES**

The 146<sup>th</sup> Judicial District Court having received the Seventeenth Emergency Order Regarding The COVID-19 State of Disaster issued in Misc. Docket No. 20-9071 from the Supreme Court of Texas on May 26, 2020 following the Governor’s declaration of the State of Disaster, this Court hereby finds that all cases filed in this Court under the Texas Family Code should have the statutory deadlines extended for a period not to exceed 180 days following the date of the Seventeenth Emergency order.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that all statutory deadlines and procedures for cases filed by or involving the Texas Department of Family and Protective Services are hereby extended until November 22, 2020. This order does not affect cases filed wherein the statutory deadlines are later than November 22, 2020 or the ability of the Court to extend cases beyond November 22, 2020 in accordance with the Texas Family Code.

This order shall remain in effect until further order of the court.
