The department has the discretion to require virtual (ex: skype, facetime, google hangout) or telephonic visits for all visits currently ordered to be supervised by the Department effective today and continuing until the date that the the mandatory stay at home order issued for Bell County, a county where either parent resides, or the county where the children reside may be lifted.

Current family or fictive kin caregivers also have the discretion to require virtual or telephonic visitation between the children in their home and their parents, in lieu of court ordered visitation effective today and continuing until the date that the the mandatory stay at home order issued for Bell County, a county where either parent resides, or the county where the children reside may be lifted. .
