

ORDER EXTENDING STATUTE OF LIMITATIONS

Pursuant to the First Emergency Order Regarding the COVID-19 State of Disaster, dated March 13, 2020, the 146<sup>th</sup> Judicial District Court and the 169<sup>th</sup> Judicial District Court hereby find that the statute of limitations in any civil case should be extended for a stated period ending no later than thirty days after the Governor's state of disaster has been lifted. This extension is necessary to give effect to the prior Orders of the Supreme Court of Texas and the guidelines of the Office of Court Administration.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the 146<sup>th</sup> Judicial District Court and the 169<sup>th</sup> Judicial District Court hereby extend the statute of limitations in any civil case for a stated period ending no later than thirty days after the Governor's state of disaster has been lifted.

This Order shall expire on the thirty-first day following the day the Governor's state of disaster has been lifted.
